



ACHE Mentorship Program

ACHE of North Texas Mentorship Program is now accepting applications for Mentors. This is a 5 month program starting October 2009 and ending February 2010. In this program, experienced healthcare professionals will be matched in a mentoring relationship with early careerists who have graduated from a Master's program within the last 5 years or graduate students who will graduate within 1 year from a Master's program. Mentors will discuss career opportunities and healthcare in general.

The Mentor will be responsible for providing a 16 hour experience that could be broken into multiple sessions. A portion of this time may be with other co-workers or leaders who would assist the Mentee. You must be available for monthly contact by the Mentee in person, by phone or e-mail. The application can be downloaded from the ACHE of North Texas website <http://northtexas.ache.org>, click on the Membership tab. The application is due by August 31, 2009 and can be e-mailed to rick.stevens@jpshealth.org or faxed to 817-927-1293. Matches will be confirmed by September 30, 2009.

Mentees will be required to complete 16 hours experience with Mentor and/or organization staff. The Mentee must initiate monthly contact with the Mentor by meeting, phone call or e-mail. **Mentees must be a member of ACHE at the national level and ACHE of North Texas at time of application; mentee will also be required to attend ACHE of North Texas events.** The Mentee application can be downloaded from the ACHE of North Texas website <http://northtexas.ache.org>, click on the Membership tab. The Mentee application is due by August 31, 2009. *Please note that the number of mentees that will be accepted will depend on the number of mentors who sign up. Please submit your application early to ensure that a mentor will be assigned to you.*
